

## Temples and Museums in the Arashiyama-Sagano Area

At the mountainous edges of Kyoto lies the district of Arashiyama-Sagano, where the autumn leaves are a spectacular sight. This tour will take you to the museums and temples in this district, including the beautiful Tenryu-ji Temple, on the UNESCO World Heritage List. As part of a tour designed to fully enjoy the beautiful natural environment and the history of the Arashiyama-Sagano area, you'll be able to connect with nature through Japanese *ikebana* flower arranging.

**Note:** When entering the tatami gallery and temple buildings, make sure to wear socks.

**Saga Arashiyama Museum of Arts and Culture:** The museum has a permanent exhibition that allows visitors to trace the history of Ogura *hyakunin-isshu*, a collection of 100 *waka* poems, starting from its birth to the present day when it is used in *karuta* competition, as well as special exhibitions mainly focusing on Japanese paintings.

**Kyoto Arashiyama Orgel Museum:** The museum has a collection of antique music boxes, including the oldest music box in the world.

**Tenryu-ji Temple:** The temple was built in the 14th century, and is especially famous for the Cloud Dragon painting on the ceiling of the Hatto hall.

**Daikaku-ji Temple:** This temple has been closely associated with the Imperial Household for 1,200 years since its establishment. It is also known as the birthplace of *ikebana* flower arrangement.
